## Another CCC Project "In The Books"

Sometimes overlooked in the process of selecting a general contractor is the orchestration of so many interrelated processes. Obviously, communication is key to the success of any building project, but when there are multiple decision-makers and tight timelines, the expertise of the project's superintendent is paramount.

Take, for example, renovating the Sherman Building (originally an old firehouse that later became a daycare center) into the bookstore at the Hastings campus of Central Community College. Five months were allotted for the project, in order to be ready for fall's incoming students.

Numerous trades and subcontractors were involved in the extensive exterior renovation, which included:

• removing and replacing 6,800 square feet of concrete paving;

- removing and replacing all exterior doors, windows and the cupola on the roof;
- repairing and reconditioning the existing stone sills;
- reconditioning the existing masonry exterior, including matching and repairing mortar joints;
- constructing a curved masonry wall/ seating area with a brick paver patio and a brick sign tower;
- developing a new landscaping plan for the building site.

No less challenging, the interior scope of work consisted of:

- gutting and remodeling 4,700 square feet of space inside the existing building;
- installing all new plumbing, heating, air conditioning and electrical systems throughout the building;
- leveling 80% of the existing floor;

- installing a suspended acoustic ceiling system with radius clouds at different ceiling heights;
- revitalizing some of the brick walls the owner wanted to leave exposed.

When Lacy Construction was awarded the project, we appointed Shannon Walker project superintendent. To ensure timely communication, Shannon utilized Submittal Exchange, an advanced, Internet-based service that stores project documents and information, making them accessible to the entire project team. When information was uploaded or changed, a notification was sent to the project participants, who could then respond accordingly, saving time and facilitating a smooth project.

During the renovation, several ownerinitiated change orders threatened to push back the completion date. Still,
